Program

This workshop will be at The Fairmont Scottsdale Princess, starting at 8:00 am on Friday, October 10, immediately before the AAIM annual meeting.

Objective

The objective is to enhance a medical director's expertise in analyzing mortality from clinical articles, to enhance skills in setting underwriting guidelines, to construct a mortality table, and to prepare a mortality abstract.

Preparation

Each participant will be assigned to one of the two instructors who will assist the participant in choosing a suitable clinical article and using a spreadsheet program to create an abstract. The student will also prepare explanatory text suitable for publication with the abstract in the Journal of Insurance Medicine. Workshop activities will include abstract presentations by students.

An alternative for those with the necessary interest and commitment will be to create an original mortality analysis based on actual data. This opportunity will be limited to 2 participants.

Prerequisite

Completion of the basic course on Mortality Methodology is required.

Each physician should claim only those hours of credit that he/she actually spent in the activity.
